### How to Enter

These instructions are for general guidance. Exhibitors should also read the Buckby Feast 2018 Produce & Craft Show Regulations on the back of the Entry Form.

Anyone who is resident of **Northamptonshire** on the day of the Show can enter. Classes for the Young People's division are restricted to the specified age group. Some classes contain special instructions; these are shown in the Schedule. Exhibitors are advised to follow all such instructions very carefully. Please make sure that you enter your exhibit in the correct class to avoid it being disqualified as "not according to Schedule".

Please complete the Entry Form enclosed with this Schedule. **You can only enter one exhibit per Class**, and the same exhibit cannot be entered in more than one Class. Please use one entry form per person.

Put your name and address on the Entry form, cut it off, and ensure it reaches addresses shown on the front page before 5.30pm on Monday 20th August 2018. Make sure you include your entry fee. It's also a good idea to make a note of which classes you have entered!

Bring your exhibits to Long Buckby Community Centre in Station Road, Long Buckby between 8.00am and 10.30am on Saturday 25th August 2018

On arrival you should collect your Exhibit Card(s) - one per class entered - from the Entries Desk. Each entrant will also receive a ticket for entry to the Show itself later in the day. You will be directed to the appropriate part of the hall for your classes. Once you have staged your exhibit, place your Exhibit Card for that class **FACE DOWN** with your entry.

You **MUST** have staged your exhibit and have left the Community Centre by 10.30am, to allow time for judging before the Show opens to the public at 1.00pm. The Show closes to the Public at 4.00pm. Exhibits and Certificates may not be removed before 4.00pm.

Prize money may be collected from the Entries Desk between 3.00pm and 4.00pm on the day of the Show. Please be prepared to show ID if requested when collecting prizes.

If you wish to retain your exhibit and Prize Certificate you must remove them from the Community Centre before 4.15pm that day. Those exhibits not collected **MAYBE** sold in the Auction held from 4.15pm

Proceeds from the auction will go to Buckby Feast Trust Prizes not claimed at the Show will normally also be assumed to be donated to Long Buckby Feast.

# Produce & Craft Show 2018 Regulations

1. These Regulations shall apply to all exhibitors at the Show.
2. The Buckby Feast Committee has power to refuse any exhibit that it considers unworthy of being shown and also to reject, or order the removal of any unsightly or unsuitable stands, receptacles or staging.
3. All exhibits, stands, equipment, stock and any other property belonging to any exhibitor at the Show are the responsibility of the exhibitor and remain in the Community Centre at his or her own risk. Buckby Feast Committee will endeavour to provide protection, but it will not accept any liability for loss or injury arising from any cause whatsoever or howsoever arising within the Community Centre. Buckby Feast Committee wishes to advise exhibitors that it is unwise to leave any Items of value within the Community Centre, which items are the exhibitors' own responsibility. Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring that their own exhibits comply with health and safety regulations.
4. Judging will commence at 10.30am on Saturday 25th August 2018. Judging of all exhibits will seek to follow the Rules and Guidelines of the Royal Horticultural Society and/or those of a specialist national society. No exhibitor, unless officially engaged, will be allowed to remain in the hall during the judging process. **Judges decisions are final.**
5. Judges shall not be competitors in any class in which they are appointed to judge. They have the power to withhold or reduce prizes for any class that in their opinion, does not merit an award and to cut, taste or otherwise examine any exhibit.
6. In the event of the cancellation of the Show by the Buckby Feast Committee before its advertised time of opening by reason of any circumstances beyond the control of the Buckby Feast Committee, no exhibitor shall have any claim on Buckby Feast for any loss, damage, interest, or compensation whatsoever.
7. Every exhibitor must submit an entry form specifying the classes to be entered with the requisite entry fees by 5.30pm on 20th August 2018. Only one entry per class may be made. The same exhibit may not be entered in multiple classes.
8. Each exhibitor will receive one ticket for admission to the Show itself from 1.00pm on 25th August 2018.
9. Exhibits may be staged between 8.00am and 10.30am on 25th August 2018. All exhibits must be staged by 10.30am and **must remain staged until 4.00pm** when an announcement will be made and exhibits may then be removed.
10. Between 8.00am and 10.30am exhibitors will be allowed to take into the Community Centre only such assistants as are reasonably required for the staging of their exhibits.
11. A card for every class entered will be supplied to each exhibitor, cards being issued from the Entries Desk. The exhibitor will be responsible for the proper placing of each exhibit in the space allocated with the card face down.
12. **All exhibits must be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor and other than plants used in the Floral Art and Young People's Classes must have been grown or made by the exhibitor as per the Class schedule. A declaration to this effect must be made when entering.**
13. Any competitor obtaining a prize fraudulently will forfeit all prize money to which he/she may otherwise be entitled and will be excluded from future Shows.
14. Exhibitors must provide their own vases, accessories, dishes, baskets and other requisites.
15. If the judges award equal prizes in any class the prize money relating to that prize will be divided equally between each of the joint winners.
16. Prize money may be collected from the Entries Desk between 3.00pm and 4.00pm. Any prize money not collected in this period will normally be assumed to have been donated to Buckby Feast Trust.
17. Exhibits not claimed by 4.15pm on 25th August 2018 will be auctioned, with proceeds donated to Buckby Feast Trust.
