

Division 1: Flowers, Pot Plants & Floral art

Note: vases and containers are not supplied.

- 1.1 Vase of 4 Garden flowers any type, max 10 stems
- 1.2 A cycle of roses in bloom, 1 bud, 1 partial open, and 1 fully open
- 1.3 Dahlias: 3 blooms of the same variety in 1 vase
- 1.4 A vase of sweet peas any variety or varieties 12 stems
- 1.5 A pot plant Flowering or not Flowering
- 1.6 Floral art: "A flat posey of flowers ". A pattern of petals, flowers and foliage on a plate between 8 to 10 inches. The plate is to be displayed flat on the table and have a maximum height of 2" from the table
- 1.7 Floral art: celebrating the "Year of the woman 2018". A display of cut flowers arranged for effect in a container of your choice. Foliage may be used.

Division 2: Fruit & Vegetables

- 2.1 Vase of herbs minimum 3 varieties
- 2.2 Collection of vegetables, 4 kinds, at least 2 of each kind. Displayed in a space 60cm x 60cm
- 2.3 Potatoes, a single cultivar named if possible: 1 dish of 3
- 2.4 Beetroot, round or long: 1 dish of 3
- 2.5 Onions: 3 Over 250 grams each
- 2.5a Onions 3 Under 250 grams each
- 2.6 Carrots: 3
- 2.7 Leeks: 3
- 2.8 Runner Beans: 5
- 2.9 Cucumbers: 2
- 2.10 Tomatoes, Cherry: 1 dish of 6 of the same variety (named)
- 2.11 Tomatoes, Non Cherry: 1 dish of 3 of the same variety (named)
- 2.12 Pears 3 of the same variety (named if possible)
- 2.13 Apples: 3 of the same variety: cooking or eating (named if possible)
- 2.14 Blackberries: 1 dish of 10
- 2.15 Longest Cucumber
- 2.16 Heaviest onion, as grown
- 2.17 Heaviest 3 potatoes, weighed together
- 2.18 Heaviest marrow
- 2.19 Longest bean
- 2.20 Most misshaped vegetable 1
- 2.21 Courgettes 3

Division 3: Crafts

Entries in classes 3.1 to 3.5 must be displayed in a maximum area of 75cm x 75cm. They must not have been entered into the Show in previous years.

- 3.1 Piece of hand knitting or crochet
- 3.2 Piece of hand embroidery or cross stitch
- 3.3 A handmade greeting card
- 3.4 A beadwork item
- 3.5 Any other craft item

Division 4: Cookery

Entries in classes 4.1 to 4.5 must have plain white labels showing the date of making and contents and be in plain unmarked jars. Pots must be sealed with a new plain twist top, a plain press-on plastic top, or clear cellophane top.

Please see notes sheet provided with entry form.

- 4.1 1 jar of marmalade
- 4.2 1 jar of jam
- 4.3 1 jar of fruit curd
- 4.4 1 jar chutney or pickle
- 4.5 1 jar of ketchup

Entries in classes 4.6 to 4.12 must be displayed on paper plates, doilies or cake boards and covered with protective clear film wrap.

- 4.6 Apple tart—7 or 8 inch tin
- 4.7 Victoria sponge sandwich made in a 7 or 8 inch tin (as per W I recipe)
- 4.8 6 Savoury Scones (please supply recipe for judge to check flavour)
- 4.9 A loaf of bread: made by hand (Please name the type of bread)
- 4.10 Lemon Drizzle Cake (supply recipe for the judge)
- 4.11 The Most Delicious Chocolate Cake in a 7 or 8 inch tin (to be judged mostly on flavour ,own recipe, please supply recipe for the judge)
- 4.12 6 slices from a tray bake. (supply recipe for the judge)

Division 5: Photography & Art

Photographic entries in classes 5.1 and 5.3 must have been taken during 2017/18. They should be printed (conventionally or digitally) on photographic paper, mounted on stiff card. Photographs should be 15 cm x 20 cm or smaller and mounts should be 17.5cm x 23cm or smaller. Painting or drawings should be 75cm x 75 cm or smaller, including any frame or mount. . Note that presentation forms an integral part of the competition.

- 5.1 Photograph: “ Transport of any kind”
- 5.2 Photograph: “Your best time of the year”
- 5.3 Photograph: “Favourite picture of Long Buckby,” the winner will have greetings cards made and sold by the Peephole . All the money raised from sales going to Buckby Feast
- 5.4 A painting or drawing: “To celebrate the year of the woman 2018”
- 5.5 A painting or drawing: “Still Life”

Division 6: For Young People

Entrants in this Division must be less than 16 years old on the day of the Show and made or taken mainly by themselves.

Exhibits must be displayed in a maximum area of 60cm x 60cm.

- 6.1 Hand made model using fruit and vegetables
- 6.2 A fairy/magic garden to a maximum of 8” square or diameter
- 6.3 Photograph “”An Event”
- 6.4 A painting or drawing—to show your love of a library.
 - a) Key Stage1 or younger
 - b) Key Stage 2
 - c) Age group 12-16

Division 7 Wine & Home Brew

- 7.1 General Liqueur (e.g. Sloe Gin, Blackberry Vodka)
- 7.2 Fruit/Flower Wine/or Cordial (e.g. Elderflower Champagne/Cordial)
- 7.3 Home brewed Beer or Cider
